

A Match Made in Heaven

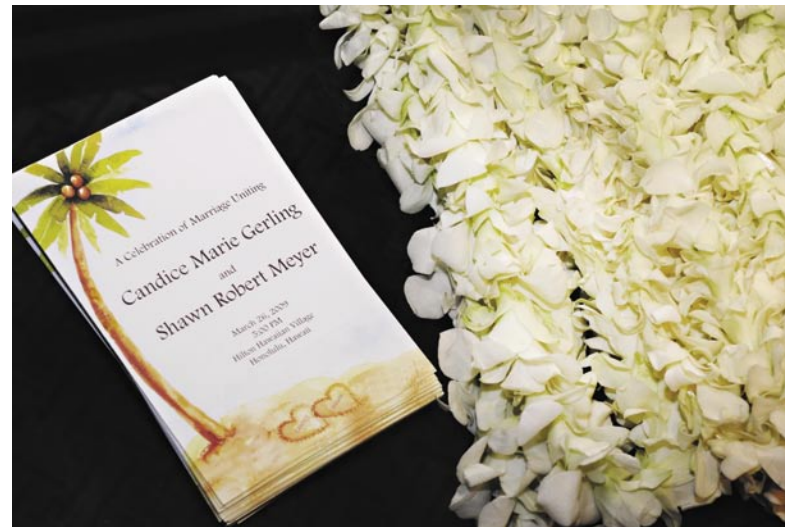
In this new age of technology, matches can be made! Meet Candice and Shawn Meyer, an adorable couple from Bloomington, Minnesota who met on match.com. What
